A fire early Thursday has destroyed a farm in Mirabel, north of Montreal.

Walls and beams are all that remain of buildings on a farm on de la Fresnière Rd.

It appears all the livestock died in the fire in the Laurentians, according to reports.

Firefighters in Mirabel were called in to assist municipal emergency responders.

Also overnight another farm and its livestock were devastated by fire, 250 kilometres east in Saint-Édouardde-Lotbinière, in the Chaudière-Appalaches region.

No one was injured in either fire, but one person in Saint-Édouard-de-Lotbinière was treated for shock.

So far, the cause of the fire and the value of the damaged property is unknown.
